Lighthouse Suites honored
for helping disabled**

Avila Lighthouse Suites, Jack's Helping Hand Inc., Dr. Roya Javadpour and John Lee were recently honored at the July 28 Paul Wolff Accessibility Advocacy Awards ceremony for their efforts to help create

accessibility for the disabled.

Avila Lighthouse Suites was recognized for offering disabled guests and the general public free use of a manual beach wheelchair.

Jack's Helping Hand Inc. was honored for working to develop the Jack Ready Imagination Park on 31 donated acres of land in Nipomo. The park will be the county's first fully accessible park, playground and recreational sports facility for children with disabilities.

Javadpour was recognized for starting and directing a home modification service project where Cal Poly students assist in renovating homes of local disabled residents.

Lee is a volunteer instructor for the Cal Poly Adapted Paddling Program and helps promote positive, inclusive attitudes toward people with disabilities among college students.
